

Hope's Cradle - Landmark

A Hope's Cradle is an anonymous and safe place where an infant can be safely surrendered. Inside is a temperature-controlled, ventilated bassinet and documentation that informs the parent, usually the mother, of her rights, how the process works, a form to send in about medical history, and a list of resources. Once the door is opened, the parent has two minutes to place the baby in the cradle and vacate the site before a silent alarm is sent to first responders.
